



HDFC ERGO's weather insurance for Madhya Pradesh farmers

HDFC ERGO General Insurance Company Ltd has been authorized by Government of Madhya Pradesh to implement Weather Based Crop Insurance Scheme (WBCIS) for Loanee and Non Loanee farmers. The Scheme will be implemented for Rabi crops (tomato, brinjal, cauliflower, cabbage, onion, garlic, coriander, potato, green pea) in Khandwa, Khargaon, Dhar, Ratlam, Ujjain, Indore, Badwani, Shajapur, Aagar Malwa, Neemuch, Mansuar, Rajgarh, Guna, Ashoknagar, Chhindwara, Sagar, Narsinghpur, Jabalpur, Sehore, Bhopal, Raisen, Vidisha, Hoshangabad, Harda, Sheopur Kalan district. All the products under Weather Based Crop Insurance Scheme are approved by the Department of Horticulture and food processing, Government of Madhya Pradesh. The WBCIS offers insurance cover against losses of farmers due to aberrant weather conditions during the crop cycle. The claim amounts will be settled on the basis of data taken from reference weather stations mentioned in the Scheme and managed by independent third party organization.
